REVIEW AND ACT:

April 10, 2017 Meeting Minutes:

Member Zack made a motion to accept the April 10, 2017 Meeting Minutes as written. Member DeVary seconded the motion. The motion carried.

March Financials.

Member DeVary made a motion to accept the March financials as presented. Member Zack seconded the motion. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Community Mediation Upper Shore - - Kathy Glace

Kathy Glace made a presentation on behalf of the Community Mediation Upper Shore on all the various services provided free to the community. She also left brochures that went into detail on the services. There will be a possibility of her hosting a meeting in the Community Center to make the community more aware of the services provided.

Zion United Methodist Church – David Segemark

Dave Segemark and Roy Thompson from Zion Methodist Church were in attendance. Mr. Segemark said that last fall the church had a water leak of 250,000 gallons. The church has since paid off that bill over time. Mr. Segemark informed the Council of a lot of unexpected expenses that have been incurred over the last year, ranging from storm damage to having roofs replaced, electric problems etc. He went on to say they discovered another water leak in Zion Church, in a different location from the last leak. Mayor and Council believed a credit of \$425.46 would be in order under the circumstances. Member Zack made a motion to credit \$425.46 to the church on behalf of the water bill. Member Brockell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Member Cooper asked about the results of the MD Rural Water survey of the valves.

The Mayor reported that road restoration work is being completed on the Pearce Creek Project. Frank Hodges is moving forward with his project.
