The Mayor and Council held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 20, 2017.

Minutes of the previous two meetings Monday May 22 and Monday June 19, 2017 were approved as written.

Financials: May final financials and account balances. Motion by member Cooper 2nd by member Zack to approve these reports.

Motion by member Zack to approve the Fiscal year 2018 Cecilton town budget Enterprise and General. 2nd by member Cooper.

Cecil County Sheriff's Department uniformed secondary employment agreement. Motion made by member Zack to approved the contract, 2nd by member Cooper.

New Business: Sheriff's Department activity report. Discussion on mileage and citations. The mayor will address truck traffic and traffic slowing with AJ Walmsley.

MML dinner in North East on July 20th. The mayor asked for people to attend if possible.

Administrator Mary Cooper discussed the town's participation in the Independence Day parade in Chesapeake City on July, 2nd. The parade honors the Bohemia Manor Girls Softball team that are Maryland state champions. The mayor will drive the town truck and we will give out candy to the children on the route. Discussion about getting town shirts for mayor, council, and staff.


Administrator Mary Cooper proposed closing town hall on 7/3/17. This is in line with the other towns in Cecil County. All were in agreement and town hall will close.

Old Business: Pearce Creek project updates. Discussion on designated water line for that project only. We received a proposal from another company to act as operators of our water and waste water plants. Senior housing project is progressing. Our grant from CDBG has been approved for the lift station. Camp Cecilton is

ready to go and waiting on more people to sign up. The first week will be 7/17-7/21. Second to be 7/24-7/28 and the third will be 7/31 to 8/4. Flyers will be hung around the area to advertise the camp.

Administrator Mary Cooper discussed CVFC carnival and parade. The town will have a table at the carnival. Possibly will try to get schools and sport teams involved.


