REVIEW AND ACT:

Monday April 27, 2020 Mayor and Council Work and Regular Session Meeting Minutes:

April Final Financials and Account Balances:

NEW BUSINESS:

Cecilton Activity Report: Report was reviewed. There were 22 calls for service. Most activity for the month of April were on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday between the hours of 1800 and 2200. Calls included vandalism on Wilson Street, Maryland State Police call elderly subject with confusion, and theft from the park (Maryland State Police call). Member Zack asked about the burglary. Deputy Walmsley had not seen a report on that. He was not sure if it could have been a Maryland State Police call. Member Ringgold asked about the wanted person report. Walmsley replied that it was a warrant served. No further questions were asked.

WWTP and Water Supply Report: John Neddo reported that some projects were able to be completed at the waste water treatment plant and at Station 3. Upgraded the chemical lines at Station 3. Over the last few weeks/month been able to get computer issues upgraded and repairs to valves. Everything is moving in a good direction.

2021 Budget: Budget was introduced. The next month will be a public hearing on the budget and it will be voted on. The budget will be available to be reviewed by any resident interested and the public hearing will be advertised in the Cecil Whig.
