Review and Act:

September 15, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes: Member Brockell motioned to accept the September 15, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes as written. Member Wise seconded the motion. Motion carried.

September Final Financials: Member Katzmire motioned to accept the September Final Financials. Member Brockell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

WTTP and Water Supply Report: Jordan Smith and Heather Perry were present to review the report. Monthly maintenance activities were performed at the waste water plant and water plant. New portable pump for wasting and decanting of the digester was setup. Both plants are in compliance. Sludge was hauled from the digester. Cecil County refuses to accept the sludge even though we have a permit from MDE as the Cecil County Landfill for the disposal spot. We have done it in the past. Working on other options. Administrator Cooper spoke to MDE and representatives of the landfill. The landfill has not put anything in writing or produced a document stating that they can't take it. Discussion of finding a landfill to take the sludge. Mayor and Council would like Administrator Cooper to proceed in contacting County Executive Streight.

Cecilton Activity Report: Corporal Dix was present to review the report. Deputies have been busy. Continued to get complaints about speeding on 213. They are sitting on 213 and 282. Trying to be here at the beginning and dismissal of school. The deputies are listening to requests by Mayor and Council. Councilperson Wise thanked Corporal Dix for patrolling. Admin Cooper said that she is happy for the communication between her and the deputies. Deputies will be present for Trunk or Treat (Oct. 24th) and for Trick or Treating (Oct. 31st).

Resident put in a request with State Highway Administration for a sign at the corner of West Main Street and Rickards. He was also asking for repair/replacement of "Slow Down" signs at Rickards and Water Streets and Rickards and Church Streets.
