**Review and Act:**

**July 21, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes:** Member DeVary motioned to accept the July 21, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes as written. Member Brockell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**August 18, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes:** Member Brockell motioned to accept the August 18, 2025 Regular Session Meeting Minutes as written. Member Katzmire seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**August Final Financials:** Member DeVary motioned to accept the August Final Financials. Member Brockell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Town Attorney Offer and Contract:** Mayor and Council discussed candidates. Member Katzmire moved to accept Charles Scott's contract for Cecilton Town Attorney. Member Brockell seconded the motion. Motion carried. Charles Scott talked about how he feels connected to the town since his mother was the first female lawyer in Cecil County and worked for the Town. The subject of solicitation from July's meeting was brought up.
